Michael Young and the Coalesse Design Group collaborated to take another form (and material) into surprising new territory While the Less Than Five TM chairs convey 'lightness' and mobility, a strong, heavy table could be juxtaposed as the foundation that anchors a room. of cast iron for its natural weight and stability. A substantial table emerges that looks deceptively light — sturdy yet sinuous; engineered yet effortless. The fluid lines and novel construction of the cast iron base echo the seamless shape of LessThanFive<sup>TM</sup> chairs for a perennial pairing. Cast iron, one of nature's oldest, heaviest materials is made to look deceptively light, counterbalancing the near weightless properties of modern carbon fiber in a delightfully crafted design puzzle.



Common to both carbon fiber and cast iron is endless craft-ability, with a freedom of form and superior function that could only be realized through these materials.
